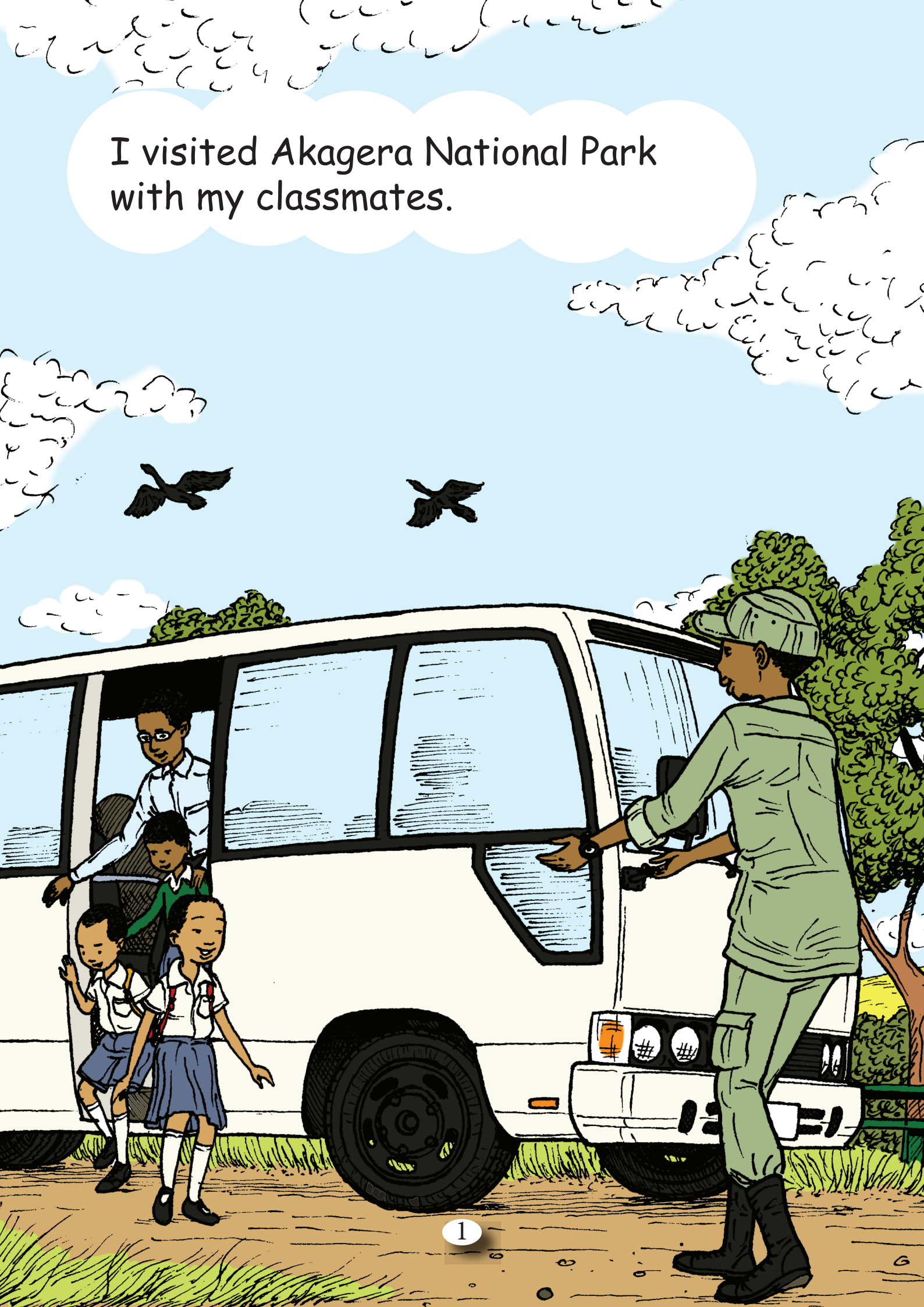

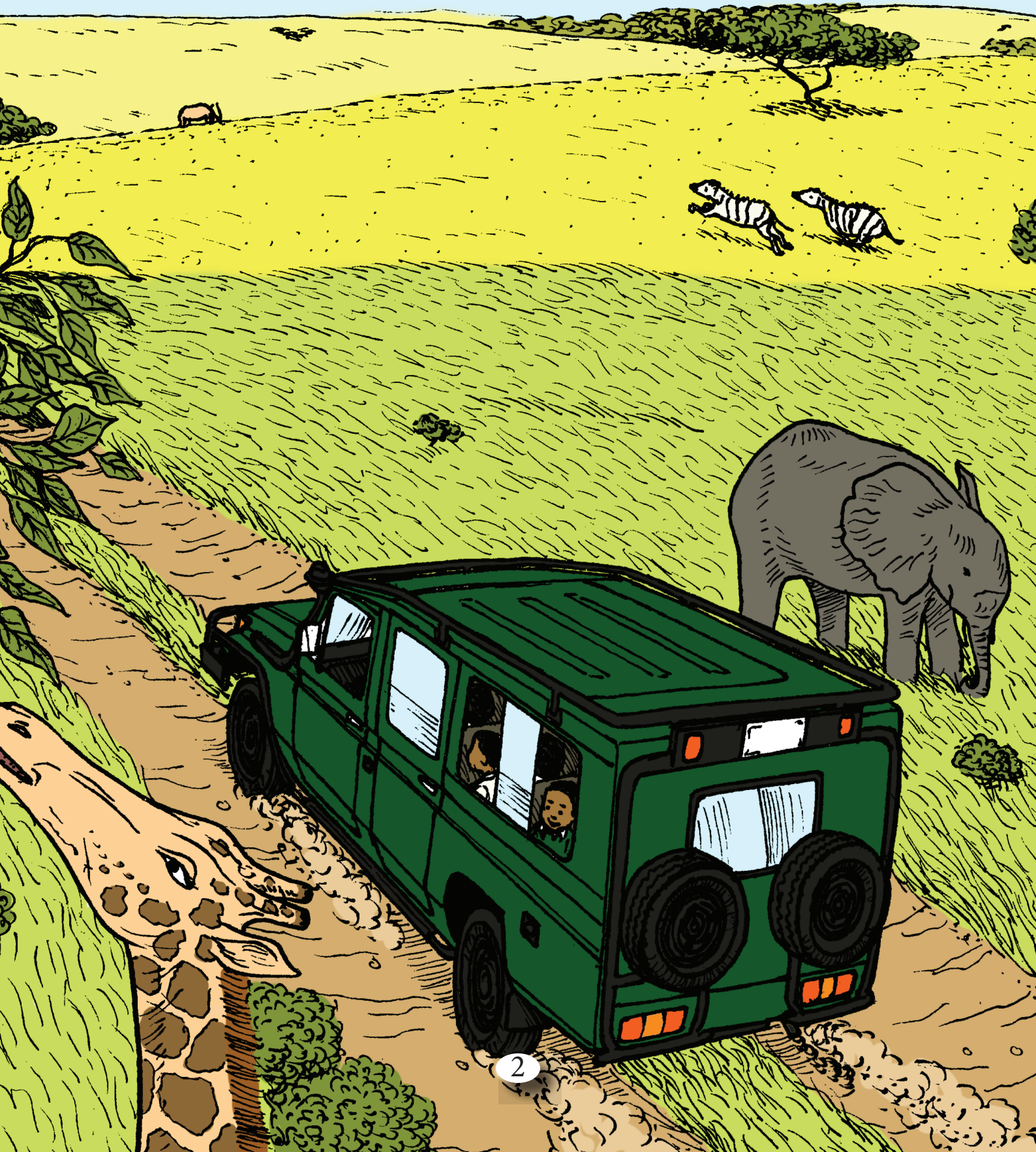

with my classmates.



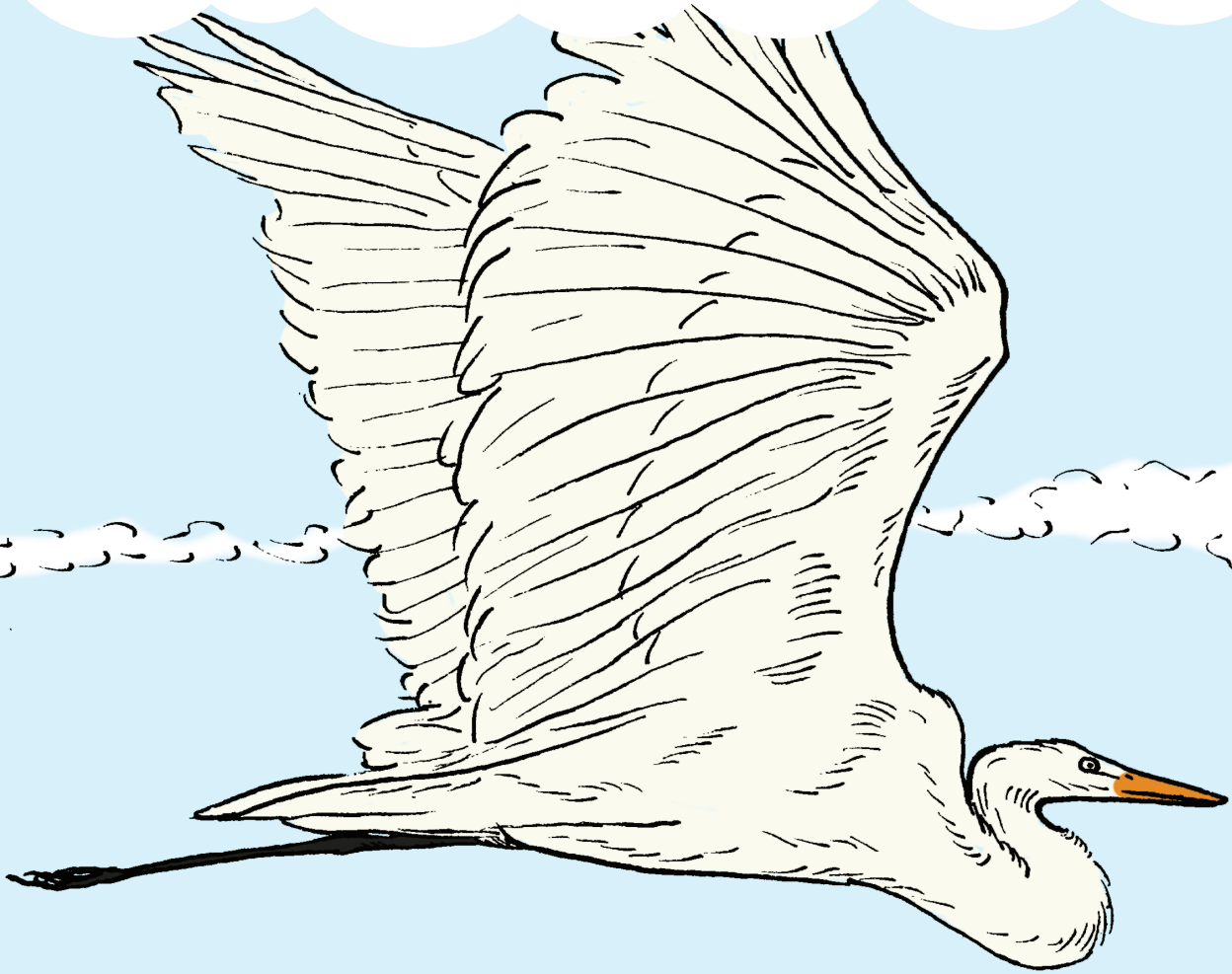
When we arrived in the park, we visited all the animals. I really liked watching the birds.

The second bird I liked was a swan.



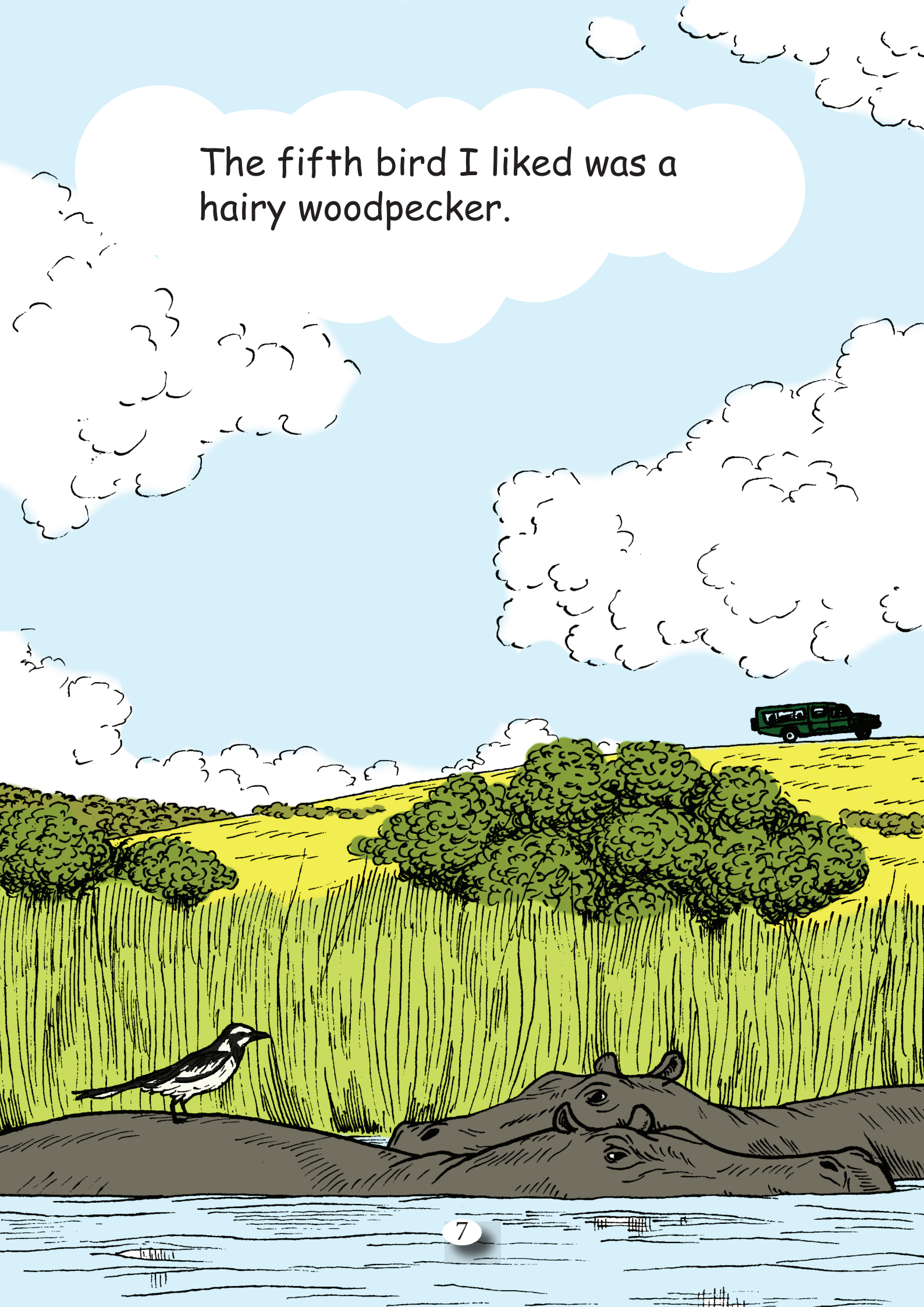
The third bird I liked was a grey crowned crane.

The fifth bird I liked was a hairy woodpecker.



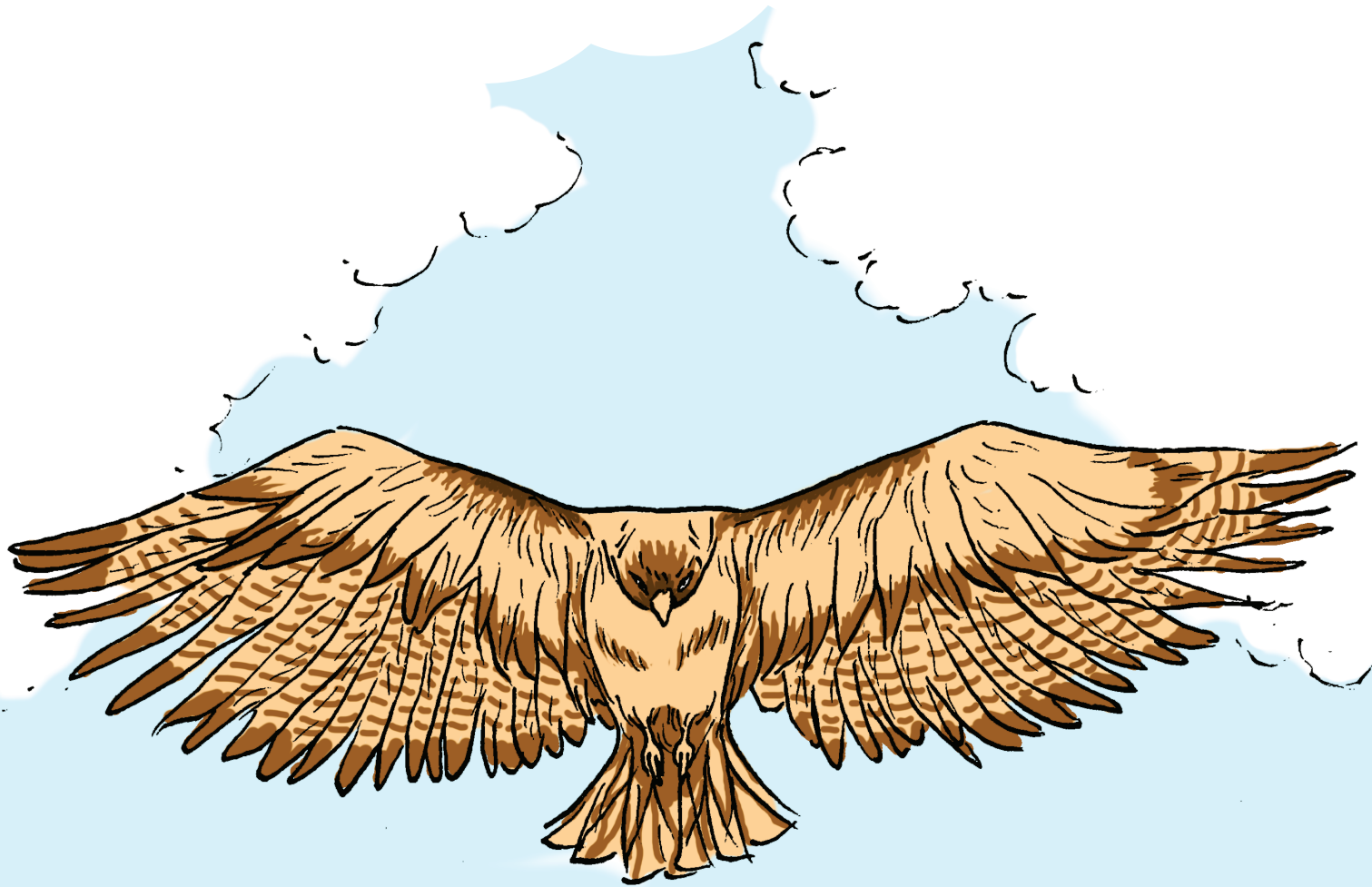
The sixth bird I liked was a raven.



The seventh bird I liked was a crow.



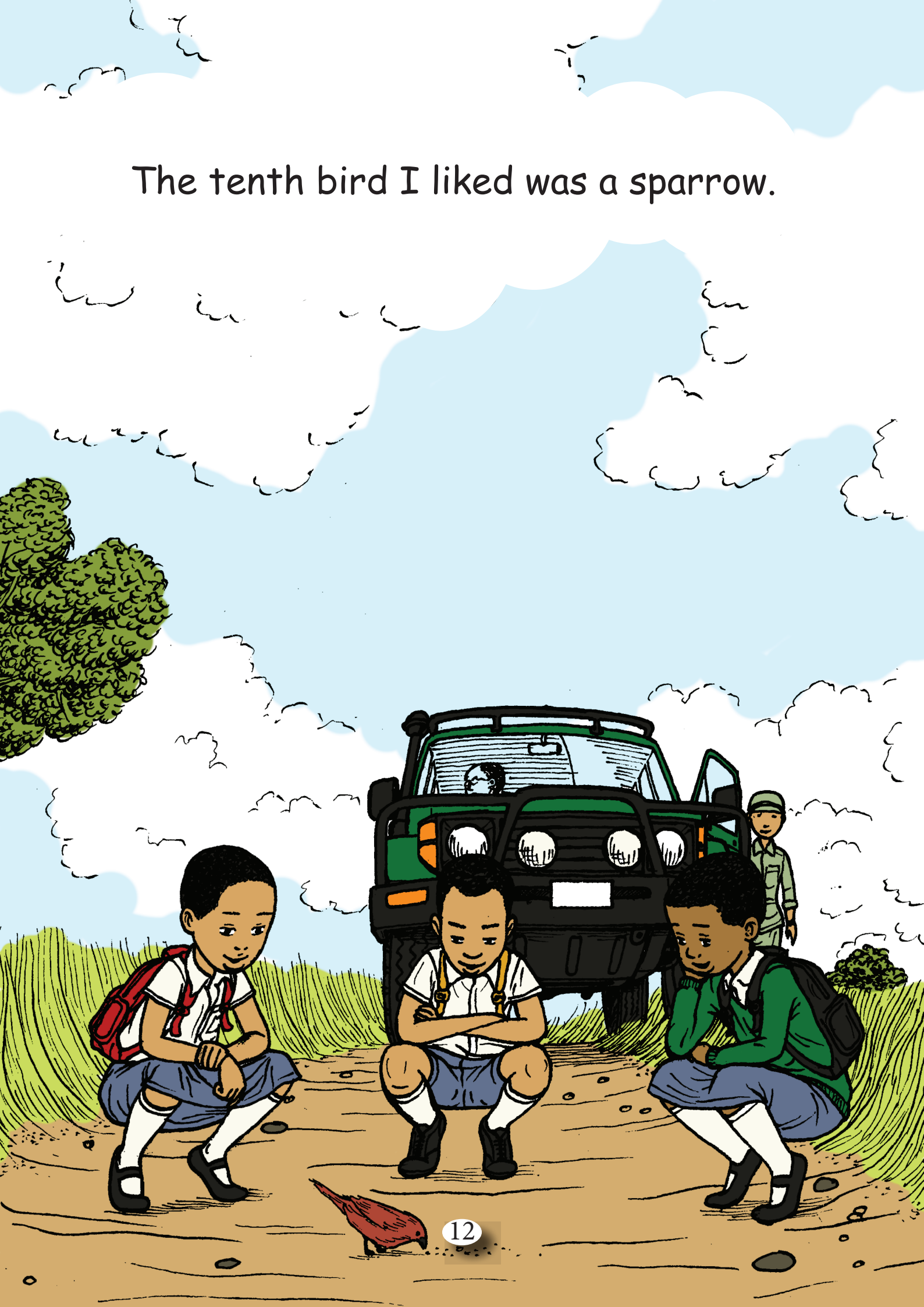
The eighth bird I liked was a kite.



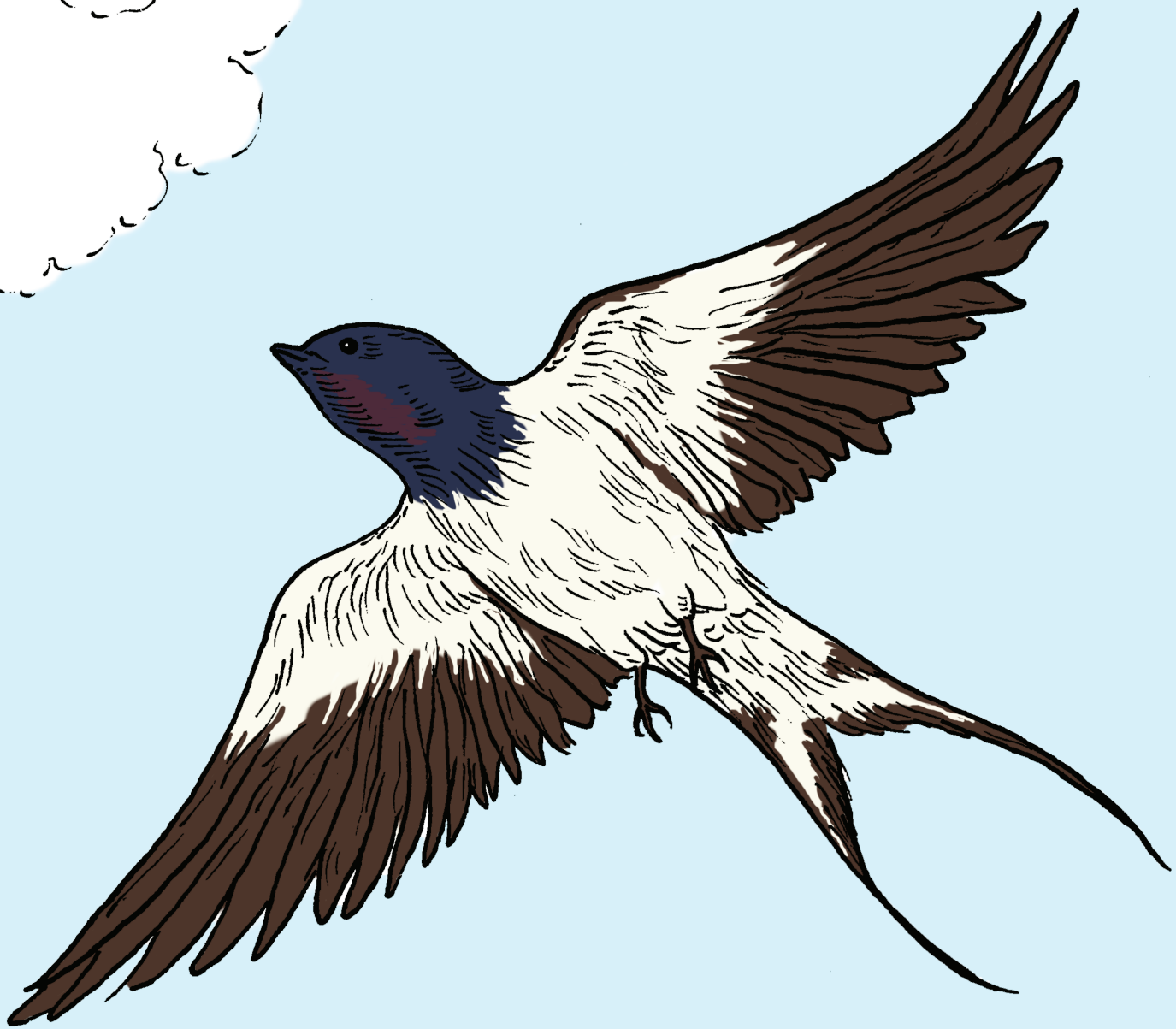
The ninth bird I liked was a falcon.
