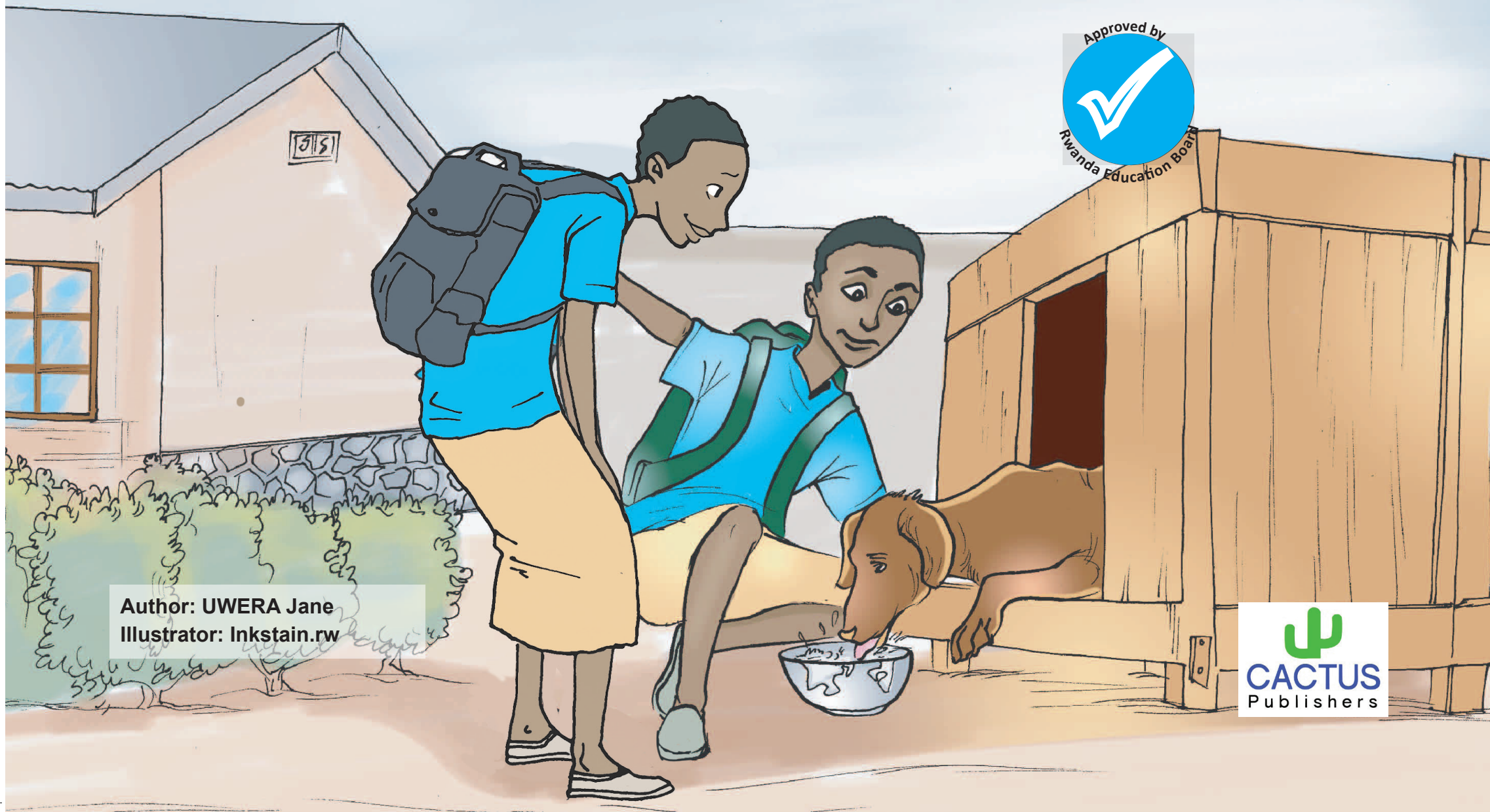

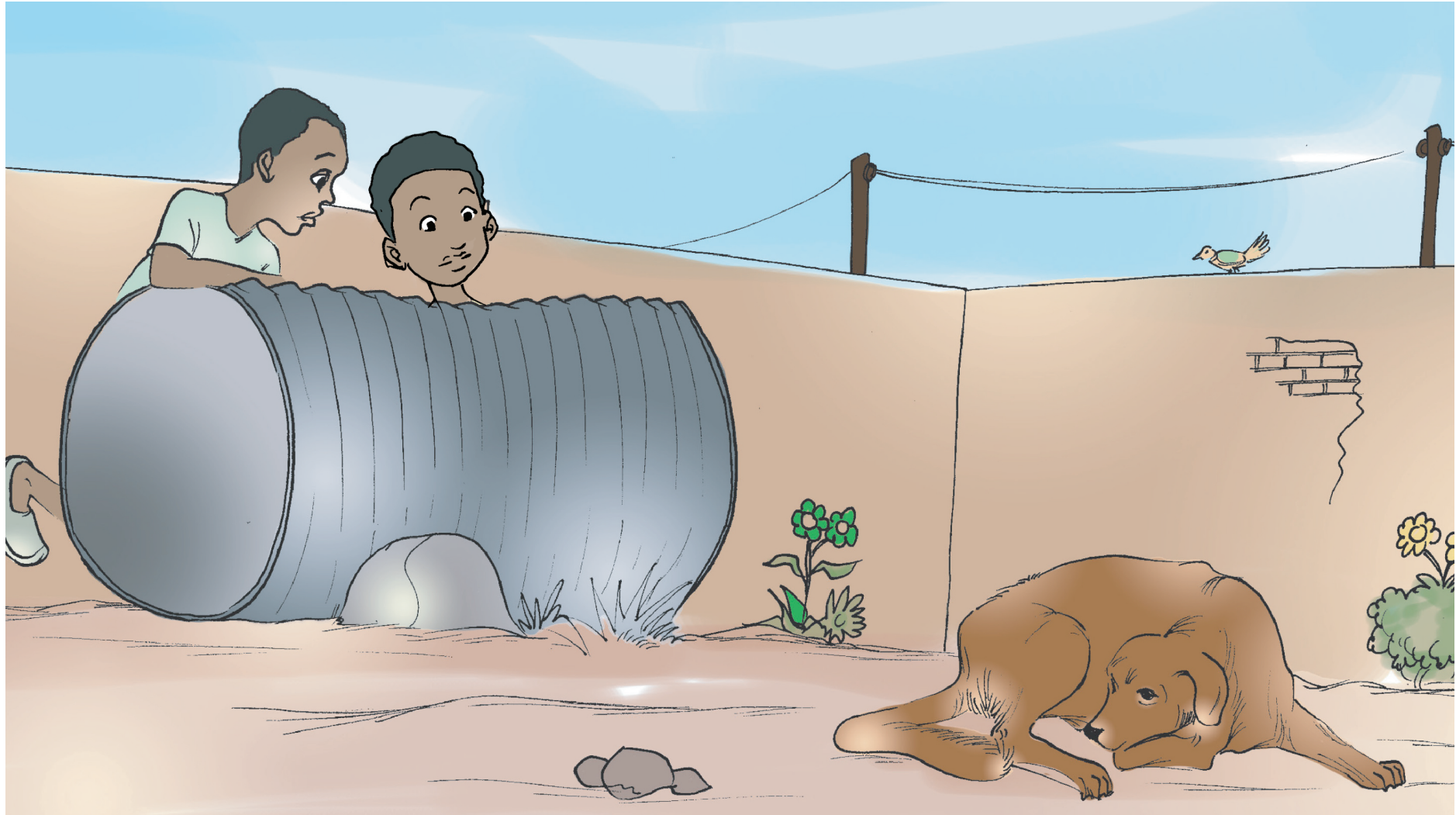

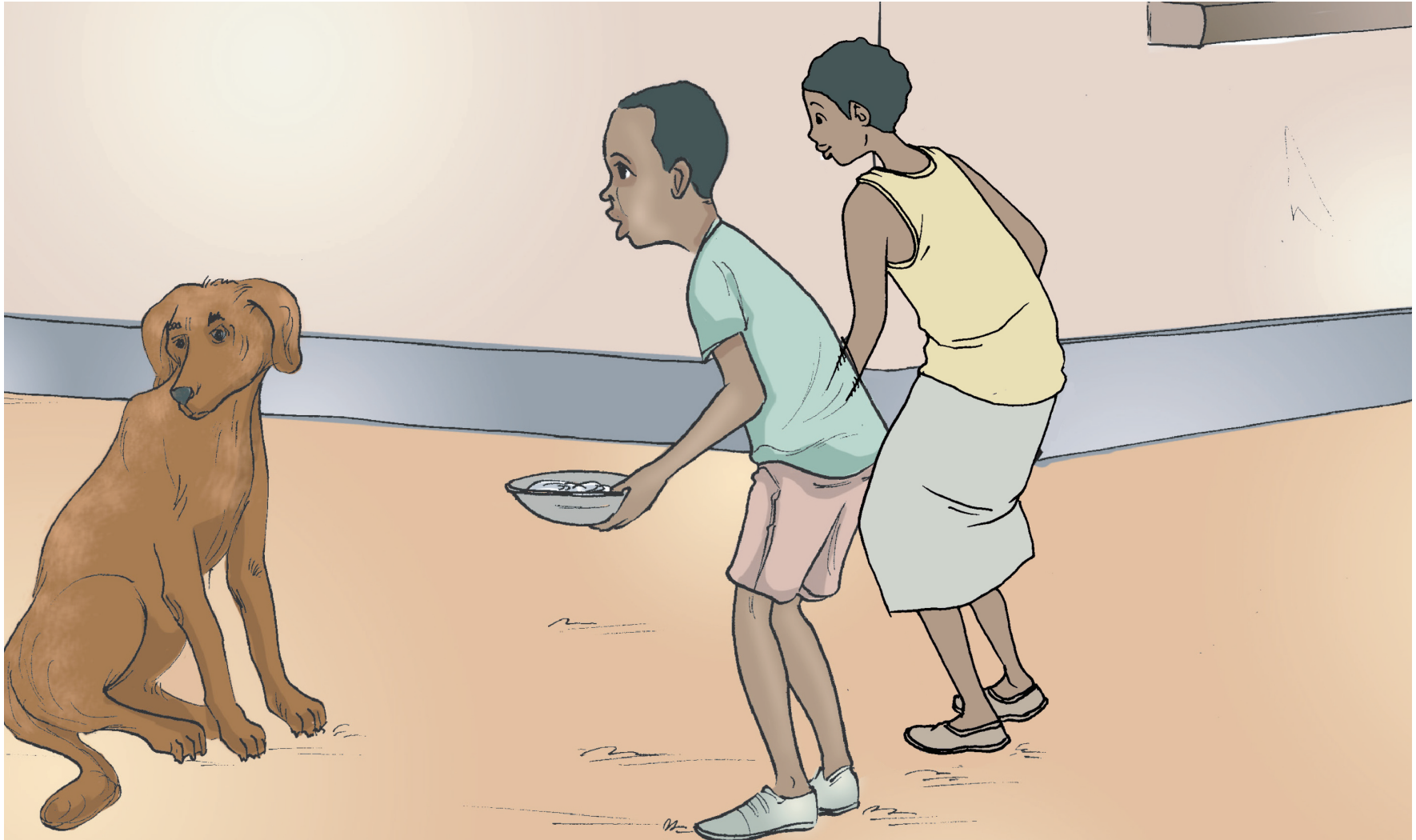
Mutesi and Nshuti have a father who loves them so much.  
They are always happy to chat with him.



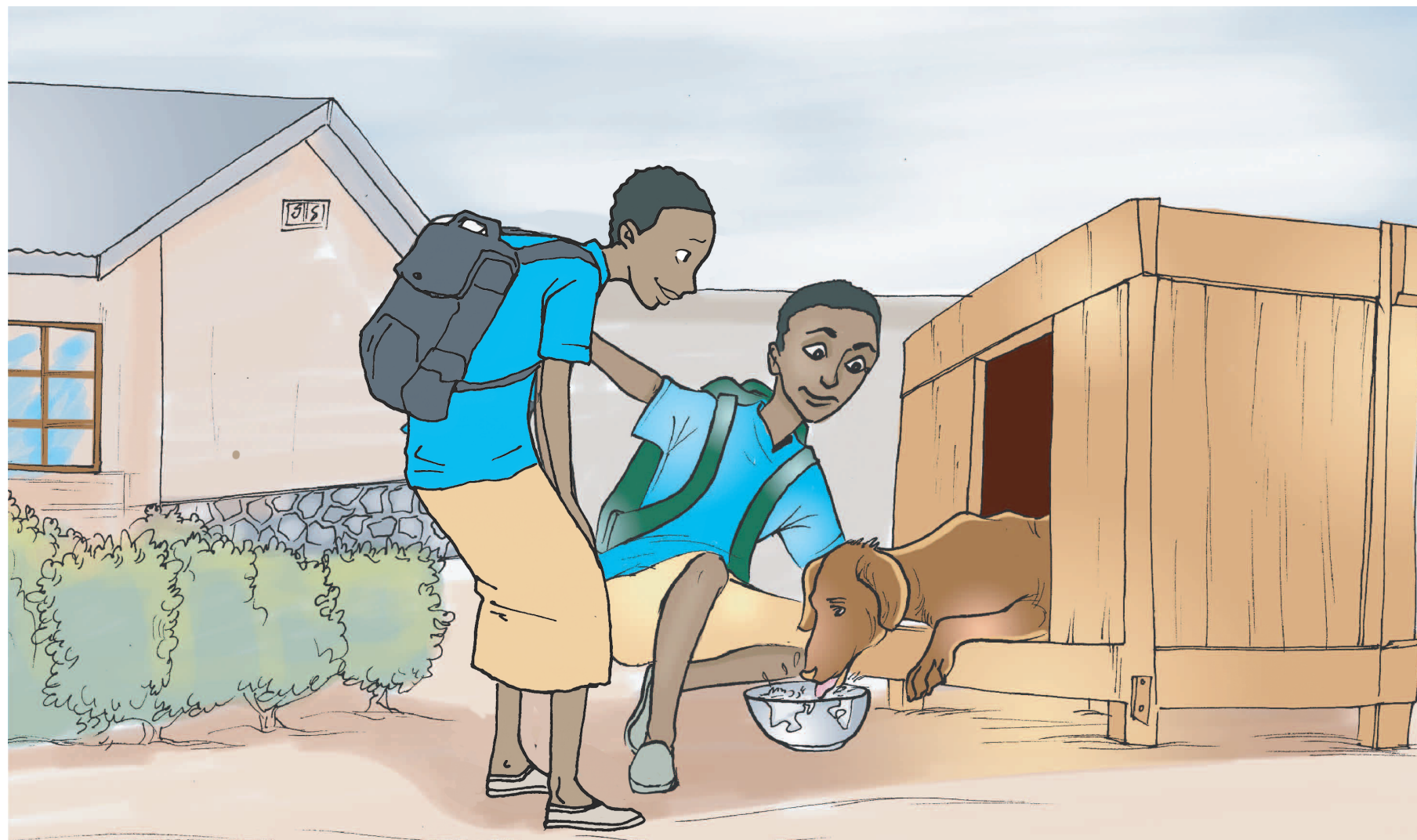
One day, Mutesi and Nshuti asked their father to bring them a dog to play with. Their father agreed and brought them a dog.



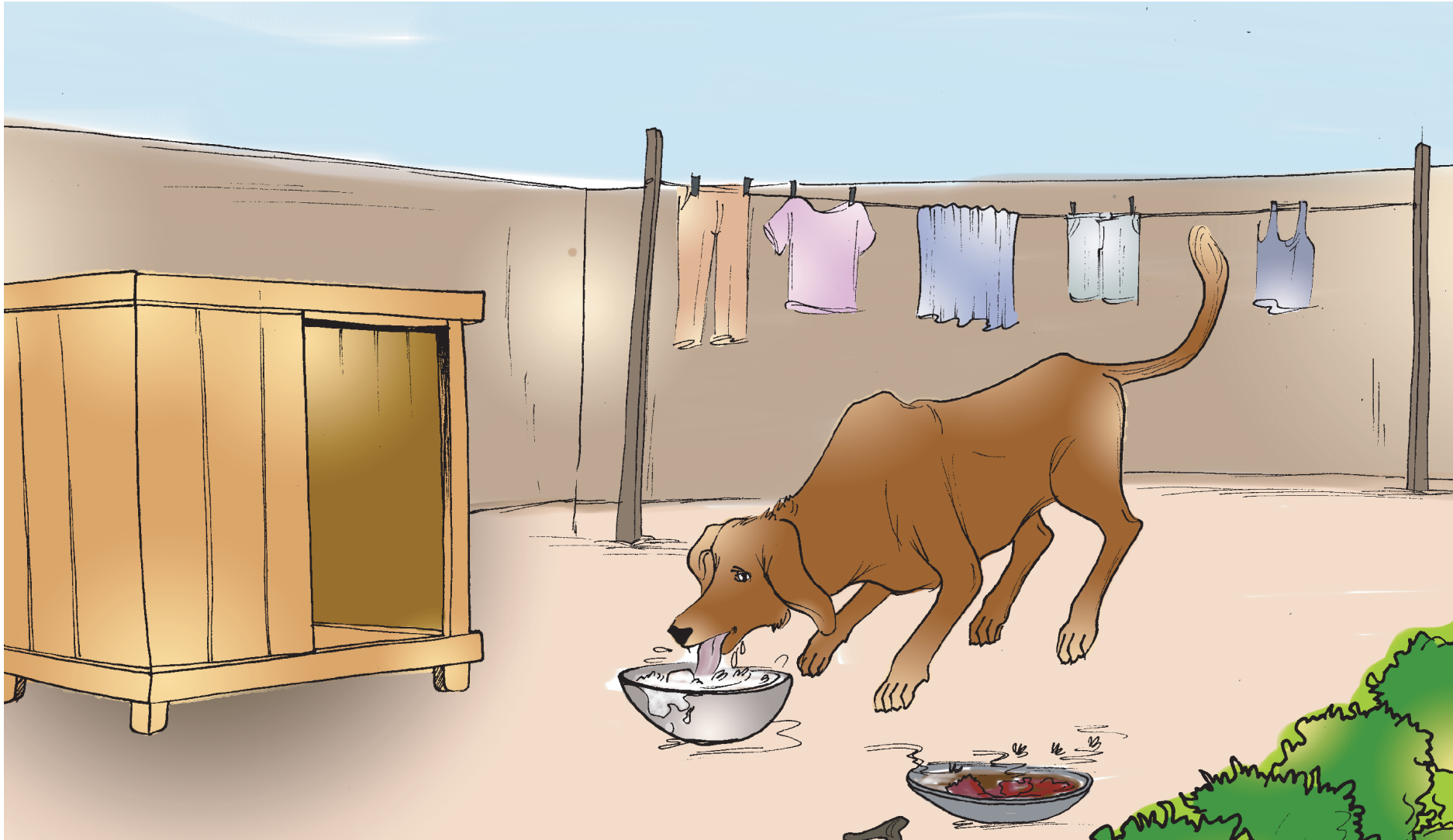
Mutesi and Nshuti nicknamed the dog Simba. Simba lived in their home, but it took him time to get familiar with them.



Sometimes Mutesi and Nshuti would give Simba something to eat, but Simba would reject the food because he wasn't familiar with them yet.



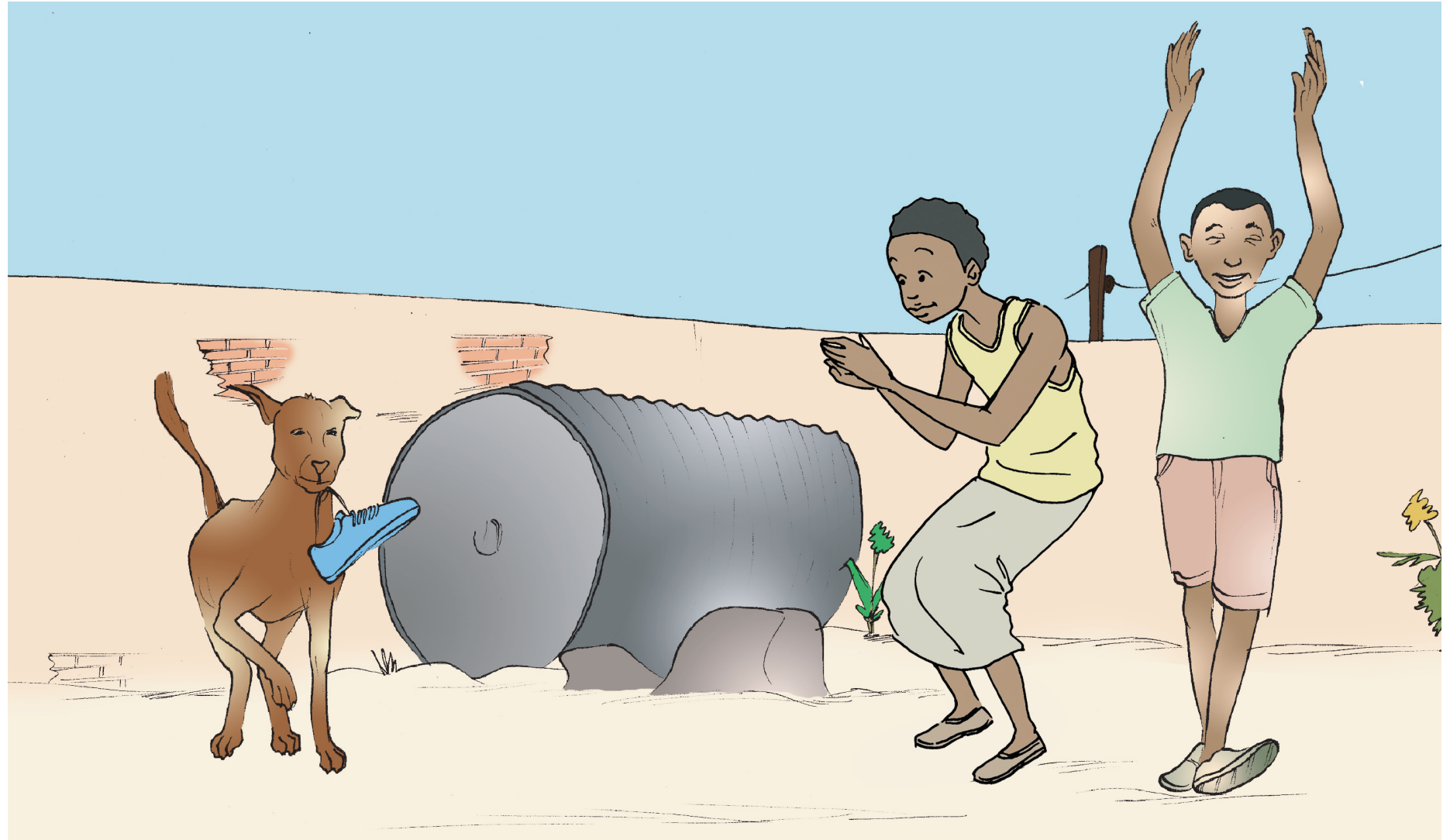
Every morning they used to go to Simba's kennel to feed him before they went to school.

As time passed, Simba became familiar with Mutesi and Nshuti. After that, they played hide-and-seek together.



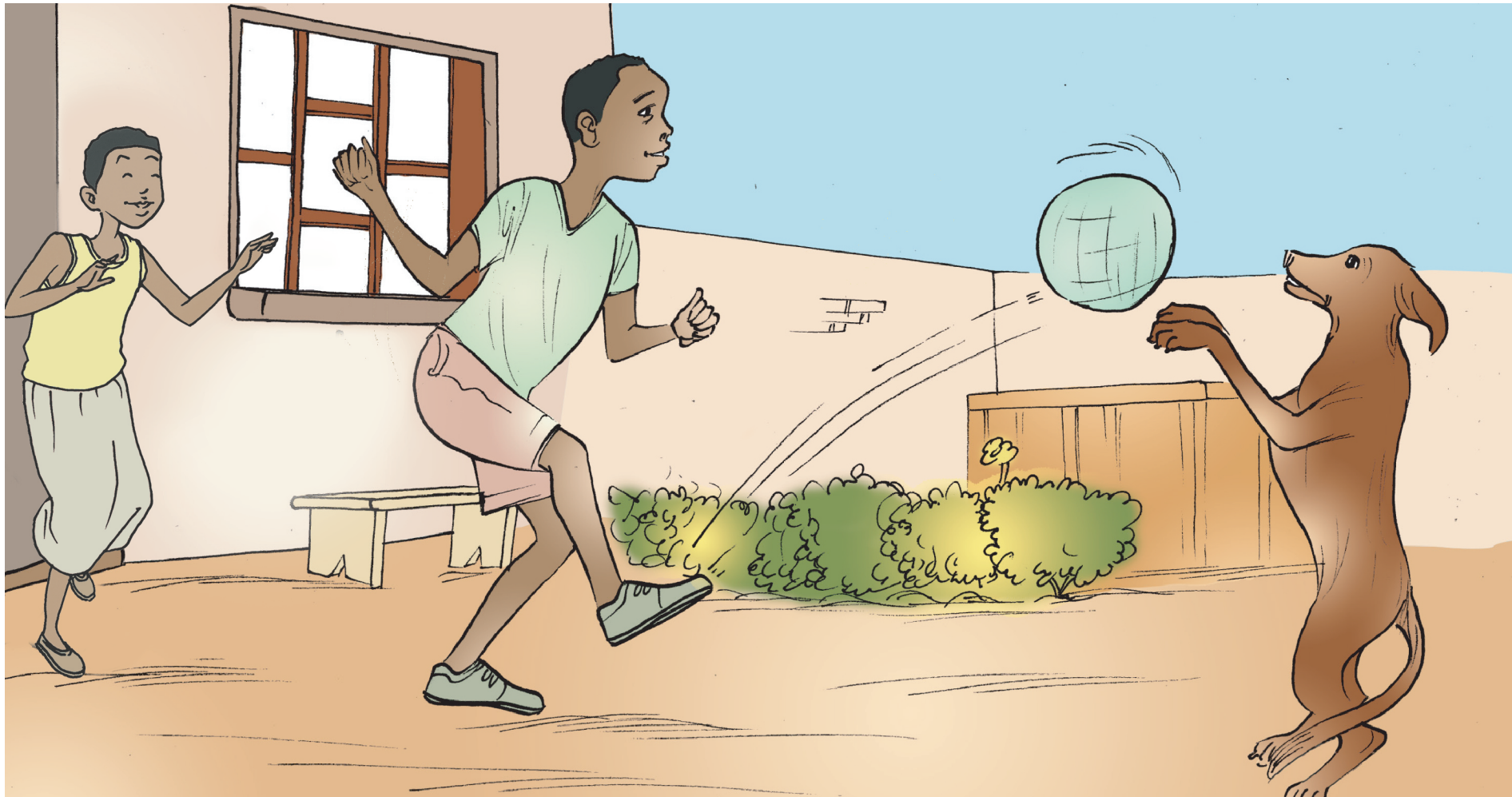
Simba was able to do things they didn't expect him to do, such as jumping and hanging clothes or taking them off the clothes line.
